Glossary of Terms

NLS: National Library Service, a free national library program providing braille and recorded materials to persons who cannot see regular print or handle print materials.

DAISY: Digital Accessible Information System, the standard for digital talking books.

Member: A person who qualifies to receive free services from Christian Record Services.

USB: Universal Serial Bus, a system for connecting a computer to another device (such as a printer, keyboard, or mouse) by using a special kind of cord.

Quarterly: Produced once every quarter of a year.

BRF: Braille Ready File, often referred to as eBraille or web-braille, is a specialized digital text format used to create embossed braille or be read using a braille display or with a refreshable braille device.

MP3: An audio file format for storing, distributing, and streaming digital data.

Overview

All persons who are legally blind or physically unable to hold or focus on ink print are eligible for these free services. Individuals who receive state services for the blind qualify for services from Christian Record Services. Outside the United States, the availability of services may vary by region due to contractual agreements.

A searchable catalog is available online at Lib.Guide. Members may reserve lending library books, download books to a personal NLS cartridge or USB, stream content online, and request other resources.


Resource selections may be made on the enclosed form; return the completed form in the postage-free envelope provided. Services should be requested in the name of the person who is to use them.

Light provides a Christian perspective on a variety of issues of current interest. Includes a crossword or word search puzzle. Issued six times a year in print and PDF.




Christian Record seeks to make Christianity practical in everyday issues such as relationships, health, and money management. Issued quarterly in braille and BRF.



The Naomi Chapman Turner Library for the Blind

About 2,000 audiobooks for all ages and reading levels are available to members who live in the United States. Topics include adventure, Bible stories, biography, health, nature, as well as devotional and inspirational material.

Audiobooks are available on digital cartridges compatible with players distributed by the



state services of the National Library Service (NLS) and digital download or streaming through Lib.Guide.


NOTE: Christian Record Services does not provide digital players. Digital players are available from the member's local NLS network library for the blind.

Audiobooks on digital cartridge may be checked out for 30 days, renewed upon request, and sent on a return/send basis. A member may check out up to three audiobooks at a time. Letters or emails are sent to remind members to return overdue books.

All digital cartridge audiobooks are sent in postage-free, remailable containers. To return the books to the library, remove the address card from its holder on the mailer, turn it over, replace it in the holder, and mail the container. Check the mailer for proper contents before returning.

Bible Correspondence Courses

Members may enroll in the following courses. Lesson books are sent through the mail. Course lessons include quizzes to be submitted.




Come Alive with Jesus is a short course that focuses on the basic principles of Christianity. Available in braille and large print (7 lessons).



Stay Alive with Jesus is the followup course to Come Alive with Jesus. Available in braille and large print (15 lessons).



Discover helps answer — from the Bible — life's challenging questions, such as: Why does God permit suffering and dying? When a person dies, what then? What is the secret to a happy life? Is there hope for our chaotic world? Available in braille and large print (26 lessons).



Life and Teachings of Christ is an inspirational study that gives a close-up look at the life of Jesus. Available in braille (25 lessons).

New King James Version (full New Testament or portions, spiral-bound).

Large Print — New International Version (19.5 pt), King James Version (18 pt), New English Translation (18 pt), and *The Beginner's Bible*.




Offering meaningful connections and empowerment, PhoneFaith delivers daily call-in programming that brings the blind community together in service of the whole person.

This veterans collection features specially curated health and encouragement resources for men and women who have served our country (NLS cartridge and digital download).


These plush animals are equipped with a solar MP3 player preloaded with dramatized characterbuilding children's stories and music. Zoo Buds are available for ages 3-9.
